

## US FTC Amended the Rules And Regulations Under the Textile Fiber Products Identification Act

On October 6, 2020, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) published the amendment of the Rules and Regulations under the Textile Fiber Products Identification Act to incorporate the most recent ISO 2076 standard for generic fiber names.

The Textile Fiber Products Identification Act requires the manufacturers to attach a label to each textile product disclosing the product's generic names.

The amendment to incorporate the latest version of the relevant ISO standard: ISO 2076:2013 (E), "Textiles-Man-made fibres-Generic names." adds the following seven generic fiber names to the Commission's list of approved generic fiber names:

This rule is effective November 5, 2020.
