

What is CPSIA?

Consumer Products Safety Improvement Act, widely known as CPSIA, was enacted in 2008 to establish consumer product safety standards and other safety requirements for children's products and to reauthorize and modernize the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC). It is a US federal regulation that requires manufacturers and importers of children's products to issue Children's Product Certificate (CPC) for their goods based upon the test results from CPSC accredited third-party laboratories. The regulation also requires manufacturers and importers of general consumer products to issue General Certificate of Conformity (GCC), a self-certification confirming that a product meets all necessary safety requirements.

Technical Challenges

Children's product under CPSIA is defined as a product designed or intended primarily for children 12 years of age or younger. When a product is found to violate restrictions set by CPSC, the manufacturer or the importer of the product takes full responsibility for the violation. The consequences could harm the sales of the product, and even lead to severe penalties to the company. Therefore, obtaining proper certificates and checking compliance with CPSIA regulations are essential to businesses in US and to exporters who intend to ship their products to US buyers.

The scope of the regulation includes most of consumer goods intended for both children and adults. Some examples of applicable products are:


- Clothing
- Footwear
- Jewelry
- Costumes
- Toys and games
- Furniture, cribs and etc.

CPSIA requirements for children's products, the core of CPSIA regulation, focus on the following safety issues:

- Lead content restriction in substrate materials
- Lead content restriction in surface coating and paint
- Content restriction or ban on usage of certain phthalates
- Flammability of textile materials
- Sharp edge and Sharp point
- Drawstring and Cord
- Small parts
- Toy safety test
